I arrived at the intersection of Michigan St and Read St. I was flagged down by a male pointing out the offender to me. The offender, later identified as Blake Devine, was standing right next to the male. The male stated Blake tried opening his car doors and possibly damaged his vehicle (he later told me Blake did not damage his car like he had thought). Blake's eyes were glassy and he had a hard time keeping them open. I asked Blake to stand at the rear of my vehicle. Blake was barefoot and his pants kept falling down, almost exposing his genitals. Blake's speech was very hard to understand and he was stumbling/swaying while walking over to me. His behavior was alarming to multiple people. I, after several minutes of trying to understand Blake, asked him where he was headed. He told me he was headed to his mother's house. Officers told Blake to stay on the sidewalk and get there safely. Blake walked away from officers and walked on the front porch of a vacant house (223 W Michigan St) with a visible no trespassing sign. Blake was placed in to handcuffs and transported to VCCC.

Dispatch advised the male and female were hitting each other. The women pushed the male out of the truck and was now walking away. The male was wearing a gray t-shirt and jeans and had facial hair.

Officers located a male matching the description walking S on Governor St/E. Franklin St. We conducted a pedestrian stop and spoke to the male. Officers also made contact with the involved female and confirmed the identity of the male. The male was placed in custody, and I read him Miranda Warning, which he stated he understood. I then asked him what happened with his fiance. The male stated he got into an argument with his fiancee over a Halloween costume for their daughter. The male stated the argument never got physical and that he chose to walk away. Officers spoke to the female and confirmed it was just a verbal argument.

During my investigation, officers found that the male had a misdemeanor warrant. I ran his name and confirmed the warrant. During the incident to arrest, I searched the male and found a socket with a burnt green leafy substance in it. At jail, I asked the male what was inside the socket, and he stated it was weed. Through my training and experience I know sockets are commonly used to ingest illegal substances such as marijuana.

The male was taken to Vanderburgh County Jail and booked on the above charges.
