I opened the door and asked the passenger to step out. The passenger was placed in handcuffs and I asked him if he had any weapons on his person. The passenger, the listed offender, stated he might have a "blade" on him. I conducted a further patdown and did not find a knife. I stated the Miranda warnings to the offender and he stated he understood. I asked him how he wrecked the motorcycle. The offender stated he observed me turn around on Boeke Rd and thought I was coming after him. The offender stated he went to turn onto Delaware St and lost control, wrecked and fled on foot. Officer Zachary stood by with the offender as I went back to check the motorcycle. Upon inspection of the motorcycle, I found the VIN# had been scratched off.
