The female stated she was standing in front of the bedroom door to stop her juvenile child from coming into the room. The female stated the male then grabbed her by the hips and threw her out of the way so she struck him multiple times and told him to not touch her. The female stated she then called 911 because the male made a comment about killing himself.  The juvenile child on scene told officers that they witnessed the male throw their mother onto the bed and they then saw their mother get on top of the male and hit him multiple times.
