A detective sergeant traveled to the Academy Sports & Outdoors and met with management, including the store director, to review footage. The footage showed a male with a build, skin tone, and physical likeness ofthe named male attempting to buy the above firearm. The male wore eyeglasses and had an object on each wrist. The male arrived and left the premises in a black Hyundai Tucson SUV. The only difference was the male in the footage had a hair length substantially shorter than the named male's when he was arrested and indicted not even a month earlier. A review of the named male's property sheet during that arrest showed he had eyeglasses, a watch, and a bracelet listed on his property sheet. Additionally, it was discovered that named male had a black 2016 Hyundai Tucson registered to him and another male likely to be his father. Investigators reviewed photographs of the secondary registered owner and confirmed the above male was not him.

On 02/12/2025, at approximately 15:32, a male attempted to purchase a handgun from Academy Sports & Outdoors, 6700 E Columbia Street, knowing he was ineligible to do so; he was under a recent felony indictment.

A person under an active felony indictment is prohibited from purchasing a firearm. To buy a gun from a Federal Firearms Licensee (FFL) Dealer, the purchaser must provide valid identification and complete an ATF Form 4473. I reviewed the ATF Form 4473 the male submitted to the business.

Question #21 - C of the ATF Form 4473 Asks: "Are you under indictment or information in any court for a felony, or any other crime for which the judge could imprison you for more than one year, or are you a current member of the military who has been charged with violation(s) of the Uniform Code of Military Justice and whose charge(s) have been referred to a general court-martial?" The male answered by checking the "No" box.

After completion, the information was submitted to the FBI via NICS, a National Instant Criminal Background Check System required to purchase a firearm from an FFL. The male's attempt to buy the gun was denied due to being "Under Felony Indictment or Bill of Information."

The ATF Form 4473 is detailed and warns that providing false/misleading information may be a criminal offense. The male had been indicted not even a month earlier for serious charges, including Rape [L3] and Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor [L6], EPD Case # 25-00158, and Court Cause # 82C01-2501-F3-000602. Additionally, he was released on a \$7,500 bond on 01/25/25. There was no mistake in that he knowingly and intentionally provided false information on the form to purchase a firearm contrary to Indiana Code 35-47-2-17.

An affidavit of probable cause will be drafted and presented to the Vanderburgh County Prosecutor's Office for consideration of issuing an arrest warrant and filing formal charges.
