On 03/18/2025, I was on routine patrol in a fully marked police vehicle. I was dispatched to the 1400 block of Uhlhorn St in reference to a narcotics complaint. The reporter advised Dispatch a white male, who appeared impaired by drugs, had parked a blue Chevy truck in the area before entering a nearby home.

I arrived in the area and observed the aforementioned truck. Via the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles database, I observed the registered owner of the truck did not possess a drivers license.

A short time later, I observed an individual enter the truck and leave northbound on Seventh Ave. I initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of Seventh Ave and Cedar St due to the registered owner's license violation.

I approached the vehicle and came into contact with the driver and sole occupant. The driver confirmed he was the registered owner, and he did not possess a valid drivers license. I asked the driver for consent to search his vehicle which he granted. The driver consented to a search of his person.

A silver tin containing two baggies containing a white crystalline substance and a short red cut-off straw were located in the driver's front right pants pocket. Due to my training and experience, I immediately recognized the white crystalline substance as methamphetamine and recognized the straw was used to introduce a controlled substance into the body.

The driver was detained in handcuffs and read his Miranda Rights which he stated he understood. The driver identified the substance as "Speed" and confirmed he had used the cut-off straw to ingest the substance by snorting.

The vehicle was towed to 1501 N Evans Ave by Tri-State Towing. The driver was transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center. The clear plastic baggies were placed on a digital scale and produced a combined field weight of 4.52 grams. The white crystalline substance was field tested with a methamphetamine/MDMA test which yielded a positive result. The aforementioned items were placed into labelled evidence bags and deposited. The driver was booked and processed for possession of methamphetamine and paraphernalia.
