Operating A Vehicle While On 04/25/2025, at approximately 0250 hundred hours, Officers were traveling Intoxicatedeastbound on the Lloyd Expressway approaching Stockwell Road when they Endang observed a white truck in his rear view mirror drifting from center to the outside white line. The vehicle pulled up next to him at the red light at Stockwell road on the driver side. Once the light turned green they proceeded through the light at a speed of 25 mph in a 40 mph construction zone, the offenders vehicle was going considerably slower than the Officers speed. The offender merged into the far right lane behind him and had three vehicles who had to slow down excessively and pass him, due to his slow speed. Officers later observed the suspect turn west onto Lincoln avenue crossing the center lane into the eastbound lanes, taking off at an unreasonably high speed, cresting a hill in front of Aldersgate United Methodist Church. Officers then initiated a traffic stop at the listed address above. Once officers approached the vehicle, they immediately recognized the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his persons, slurred speech, and blood shot eyes. Officers had the suspect turn the vehicle off and step out at which point he almost fell, having to assist him to stand him up. Officers observed a 12 oz can of alcohol in the driver side door panel, which later was found to be cold to the touch. At this point, Officers then conducted SFSTs with the offender, to which he failed. The offender was asked if he would be willing to take a portable breathalyzer test (PBT), to which he denied. The offender was read his implied consent for a chemical test, to which he denied. The offender was transported to VCCC. The IO stated that she was not feeling well prior to coming to work. I was approached by the Rp. The Rp stated that the IO had been vomiting since around 2am. They had sent her home, but they did not realize that she was down in the lobby still. The Rp and other staff found her on the floor in the lobby. The Rp then further stated that she had located a straw at the nurse's station the second floor. The straw had a white powder residue on it. The Rp had placed it in a bag prior to my arrival. The Rp stated that no one saw the IO with the straw, but it was located where the IO would have been sitting. Due to the unknown nature of the substance, the item was not tested. The item was double bagged and placed into narcotics lockers to be destroyed.
