The suspect poured cleaning solution all over the floors to try and clean it which damaged the floors as well. The victim believes that her animals were taken care of in a way that put their health in jeopardy.</p> <p>I asked the victim about damage that the aunt caused and she showed me a large stain on the front porch decking that she did not know what it was but she could not get it out. She also told the aunt that she was going to harvest blackberries when they got back but found the blackberry bushes had been chopped down.
