Faughn stood in the door and argued with Lowry. Lowry contentiously told Faughn that she needed to leave but Faughn refused. Faughn again grabbed for the taco bell bag Lowry had in his hand. Faughn tore the bag while grabbing and threw it on the floorboard. Lowry exited his vehicle and Faughn sat in the front passenger seat and kept the door open. Lowry still contentiously told Faughn she needed to leave and Faughn contentiously refused. Faughn threw random things around in Lowry's car but did not cause any damage. Faughn eventually go out of the vehicle but still would not leave. Lowry and Faughn were then in the back yard where Lowry continued to try to get her to leave. She still refused.

Lowry made his way to the front door of his home but Faughn followed him. Lowry still contentiously told Faughn to leave him alone and to leave his property. Faughn still refused to leave. Lowry walked to the backyard to get away from Faughn but she followed. While in the back yard the two continued to argue about her needing to leave. Lowry stated when thought she was distracted he ran to his front door to try to get inside before she could get to the front of the home. As Lowry was trying to unlock his front door Faughn ran up to him. Faughn put herself between Lowry and his front door and took control of the key that Lowry was using to unlock the door. Faughn then got the door unlocked and entered the home. During this entire encounter Lowry was still continuously telling Faughn she needed to leave. Lowry also told Faughn several times not to go into his home.

Once inside the home Lowry continued to tell her she needed to leave and Faughn would always respond by telling him that she was not going to leave. Faughn would pick up random things throughout the room and pull her arm back like she was going to throw whatever random object she had picked up at him. At one point Lowry opened the front door trying to get Faughn to go outside but just again refused. Faughn was trying to go through different things of Lowry's and then started taking his clothes off of hangers and threw them about the room. At one point Faughn threw a tennis shoe and a half full water bottle at Lowry, but these objects did not make contact with Lowry. Lowry then walked into the next room and shut the door hoping Faughn would then leave, but Faughn still did not leave. Lowry eventually went back into the room Faughn was in and tried to reason with her to have her leave, she still refused. Lowry stated at one point Faughn picked up one of his boots and threw it at him. Lowry stated he ducked and the boot went over him and hit his flat screen TV, breaking the screen of the TV.

After over an hour of trying to get Faughn to leave, Lowry took Faughn's phone out of her hand and walked outside with it. Faughn yelled at Lowry to not break her phone. Lowry stated he walked the phone outside and placed it on top of Faughn's vehicle. Lowry stated Faughn followed. Lowry stated as Faughn was getting the phone off of her vehicle he ran back into his home, shut the door, and locked it. Lowry stated Faughn eventually left her vehicle.

Lowry had several recordings of this entire incident on his cell phone.
