I activated the mounted in-car BEE III Directional Radar System using the front antenna in moving mode. The unit showed the suspect vehicle traveling 65mph in a posted 40mph zone. As I was beginning to turn around on the suspect vehicle, I could hear the truck accelerate due to its loud muffler. I activated the emergency lights and siren on the fully marked Evansville Police Ford Interceptor patrol car. I observed the truck still driving at a high rate of speed and saw that it turned east onto Walnut St from US 41. As I got to Walnut St and turned, the truck was no longer in view and I looked to my right and observed the truck traveling south on Lewis Ave. As I turned onto Lewis Ave, the truck was stopped on the right side of the road. As I pulled up behind the truck, the driver drove the vehicle further south and stopped on the left side of the road in front of 424 Lewis Ave. The driver exited the vehicle. I took the driver into custody and stated the Miranda Warnings to him. I asked the driver, later identified as the offender, why he fled from me and at first he stated he wasn't running and didn't understand why I was stopping him. Later in the conversation, the offender stated he was running from me and trying to get away. I walked back to the area where the truck had stopped and found a tied gray plastic bag that was laying on the pavement in the middle of the road.
