her cart had passed through the door. The Asset Protection employee was able to convince the female offender to return to the store and discuss the incident. The female agreed and went to the store office with several employees. The offender signed a permanent trespass form stating that she understood that she was trespassed from the store.

Schnucks staff showed me security footage of the theft. The footage showed the offender concealing items, not paying for the steaks, passing all points of sale, and exiting the store failing to render payment for the steaks.

Officers arrived and made contact with the female offender. The female was placed in handcuffs by the arresting officer. The arresting officer read the offender the Miranda Warning. The female stated she understood her rights and agreed to speak with the officers. Originally, the offender stated she had not done anything but was going outside to get her credit card. A later search incident to arrest of the female offender's purse revealed she had multiple credit cards and over \$200.00 in cash.

The female offender later admitted post-Miranda that the items (T-Bone steaks) were concealed in the cart and that she had failed to render payment for them. The female offender also admitted that she was exiting the store after passing all points of sale, failing to render payment for the items concealed (T-Bone steaks), depriving Schnucks of the value of the items concealed.

The arresting officer then escorted the female offender to his patrol vehicle to transport her to the VCCC. Once she was secured in the vehicle, she stated she would do anything to not go to jail. The female then stated, "I'll give you two-fifty." The arresting officer asked what the female offender meant by "two-fifty." The female offender then asked if the arresting officer's camera was on and then proceeded to state that she would give the arresting officer two hundred and fifty US dollars if he would release her and not take her to jail. The arresting officer stated that he was not going to accept an illegal offer to release her.

The female offender has multiple convictions for theft and is currently on probation for a theft conviction from 2024. The female offender was transported to the VCCC and booked for the above charges.
