Controlled Substance- Possess Methamphetamine (C), at 101 Nw Sixth St, Evansville, IN, on 09/05/2025, 14:55. Reported: 09/05/2025. No victims listed.

Officers were patrolling the area of 101 NW Sixth St, Mets Transfer Station, when they observed a known black male, Antonio Walters, trespassing on Mets property. Antonio was barred from Mets Transfer Station on September 3, 2025. While Ofc Christian was observing Antonio, he witnessed Antonio retrieve white pills from a pill bottle and hand them to two other subjects at the bus terminal. Officers in marked patrol cars and full uniform conducted an investigation at the above address.

Antonio Walters, Misty Huffman and IO1 were taken into custody without incident. Antonio, Misty and IO1 were read Miranda Warning before being questioned. Antonio informed Ofc Christian that he gave a woman, Misty, some of his prescribed Gabapentin pills for some cigarettes. Antonio also informed Ofc Christian that he gave IO1 Gabapentin while at the bus terminal. Ofc Christian located two orange pill bottles containing a total of 161 600mg Gabapentin pills in Antonio's backpack.

On scene officers located four white pills with "SG" markings on them in Misty's hands when she was being detained. Misty stated that she gave Antonio some cigarettes for some Gabapentin pills. During incident to arrest, Ofc Christian located nine syringes with red liquid inside of Misty's backpack. The red liquid inside later tested positive for methamphetamines. Of Christian located two rubber tie off bands inside of Misty's backpack. Through training and experience Ofc Christian had reason to believe the red liquid inside the syringe, tie off bands and metal caps are all used to inject illegal narcotics into the body.

Ofc Christian located a crystal like substance inside of a circular plastic container in Misty's backpack. The crystal like substance later tested postive for methamphetamines with a field weight of .3 grams. Ofc Christian located another plastic container with a crystal like substance inside of Misty's backpack. The crystal like substance tested positive for methamphetamines with a field weight of .2 grams. Lastly, Ofc Christian located four smoking devices with burnt residue and plastic baggies containing a white powder substance inside of Misty's backpack.

On scene officers located two white pills with "SG" markings in IO1's hands when he was being detained. IO1 informed on scene officers that Antonio gave him Gabapentin pills at the bus terminal. IO1 had no further involvment and was released from the scene. Antonio and Misty were transported to VCJ for booking.

Hunter stated he is allowed over at the Lincoln Park address whenever he wants and is allowed to come inside. Hunter stated D. Lester and Gills got into it last week and they were having issues. Hunter was cooperative with Officers on scene.

D. Lester admitted that she allows Hunter to come in and get the children ready on his own and he comes and goes as he pleases most of the time. However, she had her boyfriend over at the time of this incident and did not appreciate him coming inside and causing issues. D. Lester also stated that her mother, S. Lester, stays here and that her boyfriend "Flex" probably did contact Hunter to inform him that Gills was at the residence and should not be.

D. Lester was informed that a report would be generated in regards to the incident tonight and what all parties involvement was. D. Lester was given her key back to her house from Hunter. D. Lester also wanted Hunter barred from the residence. D. Lester then stated she wanted to get some property from Hunter's residence, which Hunter agreed to even if he was not present.

Hunter was verbally barred from this residence and told not to enter the property, even with permission, unless D. Lester removes the bar from him. He stated he understood.
