We arrived in the area and were flagged down by the witness. She pointed out, and we could see, the suspected offender to the south across the Lloyd Expressway. I relayed that information to assisting officers and began gathering information. The witness stated her husband bought a necklace and it was in a yellow box. The box was left in a red wagon outside of the residence. The offender was seen holding a yellow box and placing it in his pocket. The male was confronted, but denied having anything. The male walked across the Lloyd Express, pulled his pants down, and urinated/defecated on the sidewalk (according to the witness). I asked the witness if she could describe the necklace and she stated she could not. Her husband just got it and she had not seen it yet.

Officer J. Helfert made contact with the male at Wabash Ave and Ohio St. He was standing right next to a posted "No Trespassing" sign belonging to the Port of Evansville. The male was placed into custody. Officer VanFleet and I arrived with Officer Helfert. I read the offender his Miranda Warning and he stated he was willing to talk. I asked him about the theft and told him about the claims of the yellow box. The offender stated the yellow box was his match book. We confirmed the only yellow box in his pocket was a match book (full of matches). The offender is highly emotionally disturbed and denied any wrong doing.

The offender's bag was searched, along with the immediate area, and a necklace (or other yellow box) was not located. The male was given a citation for trespass and public nudity. He was released from the scene.

I returned to the listed address and spoke with the victim. He described the necklace as a cross necklace that was blue in color. He said it was given to him, but if he had to put a price on it he would say roughly \$60. The victim requested a report and was given a case number.

The victim last remembers his wallet being in the console of his vehicle last night when he was taking them home. The victim believes that the suspects stole his wallet when he was out of the vehicle. The victim had a brown wallet worth around \$50.00 with his ID, Chime Card, Cash App Card, Money Network Card, social security card, air break endorsement test guide, and free mason cards.

Today, at 12:02PM, the victim had a pending activity for his Cash App card for \$3.38 on his cell phone. On his Cash App it shows \$50.00 being sent to suspect 1 with her name as the receiver. The victim never made that purchase or sent suspect
