Myers, and Officer Harrington Assault arrived at the listed address for a domestic violence in progress. We made contact with the victim in front of the address. The victim stated that she and the offender, her ex-boyfriend, were at Six Strings bar and got into a verbal argument. The victim said they left and walked east on Franklin St.

> The victim said she was trying to avoid the offender and walking in front of him. She said the offender was verbally harassing her. She said she crossed the street to avoid the offender, and he pursued her across the street. In front of the listed address, the victim stated the offender struck her with an open hand twice on the right cheek. Officer Harrington and I observed slight discoloration on the victim's left cheek. She stated the offender also grabbed and pulled her hair.

The victim said she raised her right arm in front of her face to shield herself, and her elbow was struck multiple times by the offender. I observed slight redness on the inside of the victim's elbow. She requested AMR transport her to the hospital due to the pain in her elbow. She was transported by AMR 3762.

The victim said she attempted to call the police on her personal phone, an iPhone 17 in a pink case, and the offender knocked the phone out of her hand and left the scene with it. The approximate value of the phone is \$830. The victim stated she would have been unable to call 911 if she had not had her work phone on her person. The victim said the offender traveled south on 9th Ave from Franklin St.

I photographed the victim's injuries with my bodyworn camera. The victim was given a case number.

The vehicle then continued off the road coming to rest about 25 to 30 feet off the road. The vehicle was disabled and towed from the scene by TriState Towing.
