Parole confirmed that the father had previously been instructed to avoid negative contact with law enforcement, including custody-related issues. The father contacted me shortly thereafter. He claimed that the complainant began restricting access to the child after seeing him with another woman on October 11, 2025. He said she gave him the child along with formula and other care items, suggesting a longer stay. He arranged for his older daughter to babysit while he worked.
