He claimed that the complainant began restricting access to the child after seeing him with another woman on October 11, 2025. He also stated that the complainant had contacted him on Saturday night claiming to be experiencing postpartum issues and no longer wanted to be a mother. He said she gave him the child along with formula and other care items, suggesting a longer stay. He arranged for his older daughter to babysit while he worked. He later learned that the complainant had gone out drinking that night, which he felt was a misrepresentation of the situation and a disruption to his work schedule. I asked the father if he still had concerns about the complainant's ability to care for the child. He stated that he believed the child would be safe with her at this time. I instructed him to return the child, and I facilitated the exchange at the complainant's residence. Upon arrival, I spoke with the father before the exchange. The child was returned without incident. The complainant initially requested that the father be barred from her property due to alleged aggression but later recanted after I explained that future exchanges would need to occur at a neutral location. She stated that she preferred not to do that because the father is the only one with a driver's license and provides transportation for the child. The complainant acknowledged that she had told the father she needed a break from parenting for her well-being, but also admitted she wanted to go out, which is why he had the child. In October 2025, a female suspect was involved in a series of retail thefts at a store located on the east side of the city. On October 3, she entered the store, selected merchandise valued at approximately \$550.00, concealed the items in a shopping cart, and exited the store without rendering payment. A similar incident occurred on October 7, when the suspect again entered the store, selected approximately \$450.00 worth of merchandise, concealed it, and left without paying. On October 20, the suspect returned and was observed selecting and concealing merchandise valued at approximately \$342.00. She exited the store with the concealed items, again bypassing all points of sale.

The store's asset protection associate witnessed each incident and reported the activity. On the third occasion, the suspect was detained and taken into custody. After being advised of her Miranda rights, she acknowledged understanding them and agreed to speak with law enforcement. During the interview, she admitted to committing the thefts on all three dates and disclosed having prior theft convictions in other states. A records check revealed multiple out-of-state warrants related to theft and fraud. At the time of her arrest, the suspect was accompanied by an infant under the age of one. Child protective services were contacted, and the child was taken into custody. The suspect was transported to the local correctional facility and booked on the related charges.

I asked if he said anything about shooting anyone and she said "yeah. He said he'd shoot me if" but then stopped. I asked "If what" and she just said he just stated he would shoot her.

There were two witnesses in the park who were with the victim. Witness 1 stated she heard the whole thing and the Male stated "I'll handle you" with his hand in his pocket. Witness 2 stated She also heard the entire exchange also. She stated the male said "I've got something for you" while having his hand in his pocket. Neither of the witnesses nor the victim saw a gun.

The male who was stopped by officer stated the females ran up on him as he passed the park yelling about him calling the police the other day. He said as they ran up on them he put his hand in his pocket and said "I've got something for you"
