The reporter appeared very distressed and displayed erratic behavior. The reporter advised someone was putting lithium batteries in her bed that would cause her and her dog to get burned. The reporter also stated that her phone has burned her and thinks someone is doing it to her. The reporter was in possession of 4 phones stating someone is playing with her. The reporter also stated that people are telling her that Satan is inside of her and they are trying to get him out.

On 10/27/25, Officers were dispatched to a 911 hang-up at 4400-103 Washington Ave. Upon arrival, Officers spoke with the reporter, the victim and offender's 12 year old son, who stated that he could her yelling from his parents' room and that he believed that a physical altercation occurred. The victim then exited the residence and Officers observed the victim to have a visible abrasion to her face, redness to her neck, and a tear to the collar of her t-shirt.

The victim's sister then informed Officers that the offender was fleeing through the residence's South window. After a brief foot pursuit, the offender was placed into handcuffs. The offender refused to speak with Officers.

Officers then went back to the residence and spoke to the victim who stated that the offender, her husband, had been emotionally distant all day. The victim stated that she wished to comfort the offender, but that he kept pushing her away, down on their bed, or down to the floor. The victim stated that this has been occurring more frequently, and Officers observed the victim to have old bruises to her arms.

The victim stated that she and the offender had gotten into three physical altercations throughout the day. The victim stated that the offender had been pushing her down, and applying pressure to her neck. The victim stated that during the first altercation the offender used 2 hands to strangle her and during the second altercation the offender used 1 hand to strangle her. The victim stated that the third altercation, during which her son called, the offender was grabbing at her face and upper chest area and trying to push her.

The victim contributed the redness to her neck from the strangulation, and the abrasion to her face and the tear to her shirt collar to be from the pushing and grabbing by the offender. Officers found the injuries to be consistent with the victim's statement from their training and experience. The victim's injuries were documented with Officers' body worn cameras. The offender was transported to Deaconess Midtown for jail clearance and then to VCCC to be booked in.
