Myers, and Officer Harrington arrived at the listed address for a domestic violence in progress. Officers Trueblood and Hollis had already made contact with the male subject of the call, Jackie Woods Sr, and placed him in handcuffs. Officer Trueblood searched Woods and located a green, plant-like substance and two glass smoking devices in his pockets. Through his training and experience, Officer Trueblood knew the substance to be marijuana and the smoking devices to be used to ingest illegal narcotics. Officer Trueblood read Woods his Miranda Rights, and he agreed to speak with officers. Woods stated he used the black and blue smoking device to smoke marijuana. Woods said the clear smoking device was used to smoke methamphetamine. Woods said the clear smoking device was not his. He stated he was inside a motel room and came out to his car to find the female subject of the call, Jodi Harris, in the backseat of his car, unclothed, with the clear smoking device in her mouth. Woods said he took the clear smoking device from Harris just before officers arrived. I made contact with Harris. Harris was sitting in the back seat of Woods' vehicle without a shirt on. Harris said the clear smoking device belonged to Woods. She first said she found it and hit Woods on the head with it. She then said she actually threw it on the ground. Harris then said she had not seen the clear smoking device in over a month. Officer Harrington and I seized the substance and paraphernalia. The substance tested positive for marijuana using a Nark II test. The field weight of the marijuana was 0.32 grams. The marijuana was marked for destruction and placed in the VCCC drop box. The paraphernalia was put in evidence in the VCCC drop box. Harris was cited (UTT #8220199944) and released.
