	<p>customers, and the subject brought attention to himself.</p> <p>As the man above continued walking across the parking lot, he suddenly sat down and lay down in the middle of the path taken by vehicles. An EPD Detective identified himself as a law enforcement officer as he approached the male; it was apparent that the male had difficulty maintaining control of his bodily movements and had a near inability to provide his name. The subject attempted to walk away from the officer, who then placed him in handcuffs for both their safety. The subject was escorted out of the lane of travel and taken to a safe area where they could be seated and out of harm's way. The detective explained to the man that he was in a public place and appeared in a state of intoxication, and that he needed to identify himself. The subject continued to have difficulty providing his name, but it was not clear that he was trying to be evasive with the officer. The individual continued to struggle with controlling his erratic movements and behavior, even when seated on the ground. He attempted to stand several times, prompting the officer to request an additional unit. The subject provided a first name to the officer, who then took a photograph of him and sought assistance identifying the man through a facial recognition database; he was positively identified a few moments later. The subject appeared to gag and had difficulty breathing; therefore, the detective requested medical assistance. Additional officers arrived to help the detective.</p> <p>The subject lost consciousness shortly thereafter and appeared to breathe in an agonal manner; two doses of NARCAN were administered, but its effectiveness was not immediately apparent, and the male continued to exhibit agonal breathing and a lack of consciousness. An ambulance arrived a short time later and assisted with aid; it was discovered that the subject's body temperature was very high at approximately 104 degrees. Medics continued to aid the subject, but his condition deteriorated, and he was transported to Deaconess Midtown Hospital for advanced treatment. There, medical staff immediately intubated the subject and confirmed a core body temperature of approximately 107.06 degrees. Staff began lifesaving measures and were eventually able to determine that the individual had ingested methamphetamine. Still, they believed that it was a mixture of narcotics with his prescribed medication that caused his excessive hyperthermia and was, therefore, a medical emergency.</p> <p>It is unknown if the subject's narcotics use or the medical emergency caused his erratic behavior before losing consciousness in the parking lot of Hucks; therefore, criminal charges will not be filed in this investigation. Still, the subject was identified as being on supervised release, and it was highly likely that he was not supposed to consume methamphetamine in any amount. His probation officer was contacted and informed of the situation.</p>
