Of A Crash-Injury Crash On the listed date, officers were dispatched to a motor vehicle crash where driver's were complaining of injury. EFD station#15 arrived on scene and were advised by the witness that the driver of the Honda CRV had fled the scene along with the female passenger. I, Officer Hastings, arrived a short time later and spoke with all who were still on scene. The driver of the Nissan Rogue, listed as the victim, stated he was driving his vehicle north on Rotherwood Ave and was preparing to cross Covert Ave. The victim stated he stopped and then proceeded onto Covert Ave. The victim stated he didn't see the Honda CRV until the collision occurred. The victim provided all the necessary information to complete an accident report. The victim was complaining of pain to his back. At the time of the report, the victim refused an ambulance. The witness stated after observing the collision, he spoke to the driver of the Honda CRV and stated the driver appeared injured. I asked the witness if he could describe the driver of the Honda and he stated it was an older black male, late 40's early 50's with a bald head. The witness observed the driver, later identified at the offender, get out of the front driver's side and leave with the female passenger north on Rotherwood Ave. The witness did not observed the offender attempt to speak with the victim. After the vehicles were cleared from the scene, Officer Sumrall, Officer S. King and I went to the offender's address on Covert. As we walked up to the address, a male subject, matching the description given by the witness, was sitting on the front porch. I made contact with the offender and advised him of his Miranda Warnings. I asked the offender if he was the driver of the vehicle involved in a collision on Covert Ave. The offender said he was, but said the other driver pulled out in front of him. I asked the offender why he left the scene of the collision and he said he was scared. When asked if he had insurance on the vehicle, the offender stated the insurance had expired. I ran the offender's driving status through the BMV and it showed he only had an Indiana ID card. The offender was arrested and taken to Deaconess-Midtown for medical clearance.
