The witness observed the driver, later identified at the offender, get out of the front driver's side and leave with the female passenger north on Rotherwood Ave. The witness did not observed the offender attempt to speak with the victim. After the vehicles were cleared from the scene, Officer Sumrall, Officer S. King and I went to the offender's address on Covert. As we walked up to the address, a male subject, matching the description given by the witness, was sitting on the front porch. I made contact with the offender and advised him of his Miranda Warnings.
