Charles said the white truck had 4 white male occupants. He said the male in the rear passenger seat, Offender 1, stepped out of the vehicle and unholstered a black 9mm handgun. Charles said Offender 1 held the gun at his side as he approached the older black male driver of the Tahoe. Charles then approached Offender 1 and attempted to deescalate the situation verbally, and he said Offender 1 pointed the firearm at him. Charles said the male in the front passenger seat of the white truck, Offender 2, then placed a black 9mm handgun on the dashboard but did not point it at him. Charles described the offenders as white males, mid to late 20s, stocky build, approximately 5`11", with long beards.

Charles said Offender 1 then ran into a nearby house, 917 W Oregon St, and came back out without the firearm in his hand. Charles said the white truck then left heading east on Oregon St. Charles said the Tahoe then went south on Third Ave.

Dennis Barker, the witness, described the incident as Charles did. Dennis said he went back into the listed residence and retrieved his firearm when Offender 1 threatened Charles with his firearm.

Officer Alford and I attempted to make contact with the residents of 917 W Oregon St, but they did not answer the door.

Officers later located the suspect at a nearby residence. He was detained, advised of his rights, and consented to a vehicle search. No firearm was located during the inventory tow of the vehicle. The suspect admitted to being at the carwash, engaging in a verbal altercation, and using racial slurs toward the employees but denied displaying a weapon or making any threats. The suspect was transported to the local detention center and booked on related charges.
