	On 11/20/25 at approximately 0748, I, Officer J. Myers, was on routine patrol traveling south on Second Ave approaching Louisiana St. I observed a white female wearing a winter coat walking south on Second Ave in the middle of the street. The female was directly in front of me, and I was unable to pass her due to the street being too narrow. There are available sidewalks on both sides of Second Ave at that location. I initiated a stop on the female offender, Phillips, on Second Ave just south of Louisiana St for failing to use the available sidewalks.		
	I approached Phillips and asked for consent to search her. Phillips gave consent. I located a grey plastic bag in one of the pockets on the right side of her winter coat. In the plastic bag, I located a cigarette carton containing four white papers rolled with a green, plant-like substance. I also located a plastic bag containing residue of a dry, green, leafy substance. Through my training and experience, I knew the substance in the clear plastic bag to be synthetic cannabinoid. From that, I inferred the substance in the white paper to be synthetic cannabinoid.		
	I also located two metal smoking devices in the grey plastic bag, one with a purple metal sleeve. Both devices had burnt residue. Through my training and experience, I knew these devices to be used to ingest illegal narcotics.		
	I read Phillips her Miranda Rights, and she agreed to speak to me. Phillips denied using the metal devices to ingest narcotics but said she sometimes smokes marijuana rolled in papers. Phillips stated she found the metal smoking devices and the clear bag with synthetic cannabinoid residue on the ground.		
	Phillips was initially cited for Possession of a Schedule I, II, III, IV, V Substance, Possession of Paraphernalia, and released from the scene.		
	The residue inside the clear plastic bag later tested positive for synthetic cannabinoid using a Nark II test. The field weight of the residue was <.01g. The green, plant-like substance rolled in the white papers tested positive for marijuana using a Nark II test. The field weight of the substance and four rolled papers was 1.63g.		
	I amended the charges on Phillips' citation to Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Paraphernalia. The substances and smoking devices were submitted into evidence in the west sector drop box.
