The victim said the Lincoln followed him back onto Cameo Rd and back to the residence of the witness. The witness, who was the front seat passenger, told the victim not to pull into his driveway, but to turn around and leave the neighborhood. The victim said when he turned around, the Lincoln was blocking the roadway out. The victim said he stopped his vehicle and observed the front seat passenger(unknown offender) exit. The offender approached the victim's car and the victim stated the offender pushed in the outside rearview mirror and reached into the driver's side compartment, slapping the victim on the left side of his face and then trying to punch him. The witness stated at this point he was already on the phone with 911 dispatch. The victim said the involved other and offender left the area in an unknown direction.
